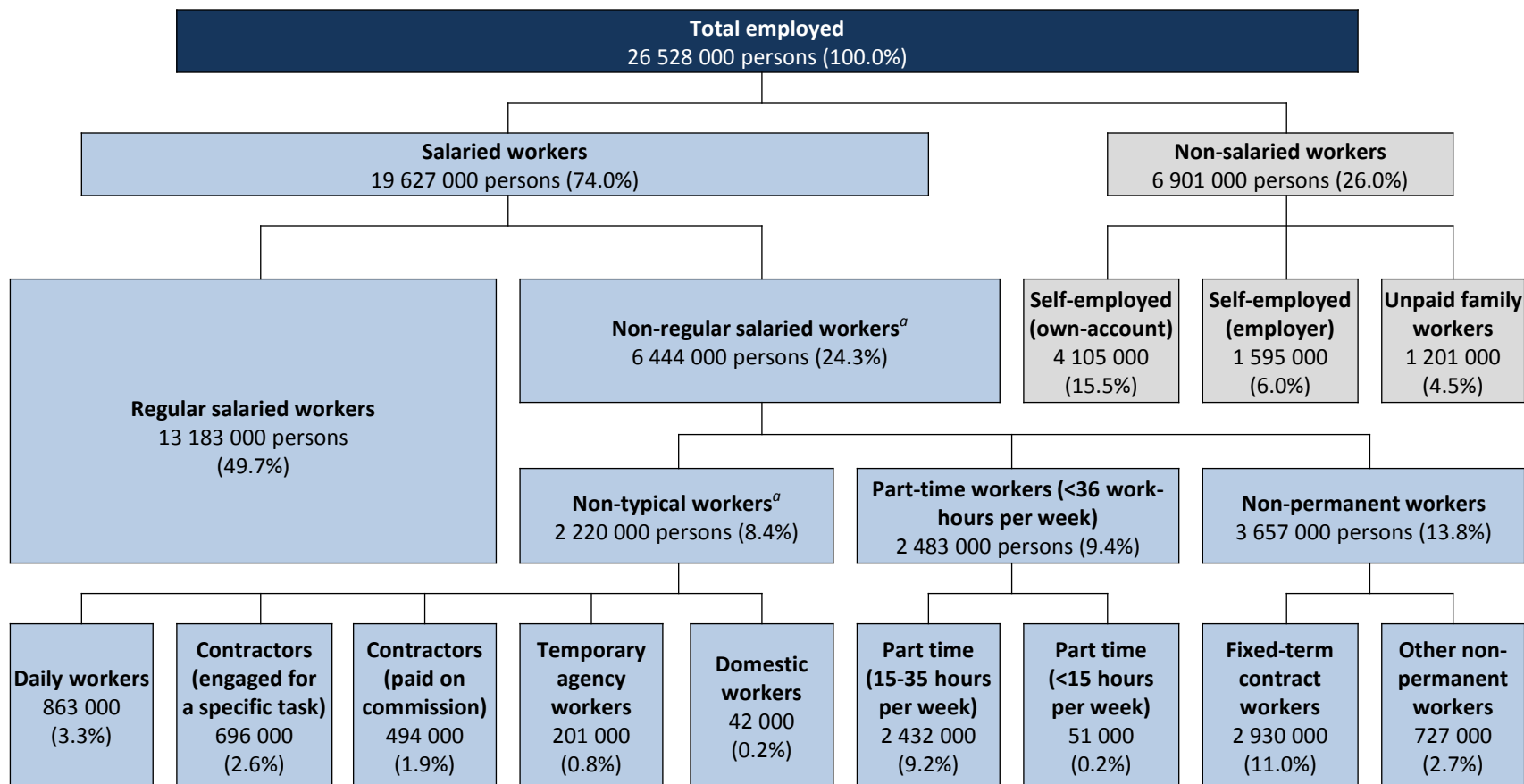


Figure 1: Korea's diverse labour market impacts job quality, earnings and social protection coverage.
