This event will analyse core requirements for crafting effective implementing guidelines under the Paris Agreement and highlight ways in which Parties may operationalize these guidelines. It will focus on themes related to transparency, including on how Parties may operationalize flexibility, and on determinants of and incentives for monitoring, reporting, and compliance from a multi-stakeholder perspective (including Parties, civil society, firms, and individuals). It will also look into efforts to review and promote progress under the Paris Agreement, including individual and collective review, and linkages across different elements of the Paris Agreement.
