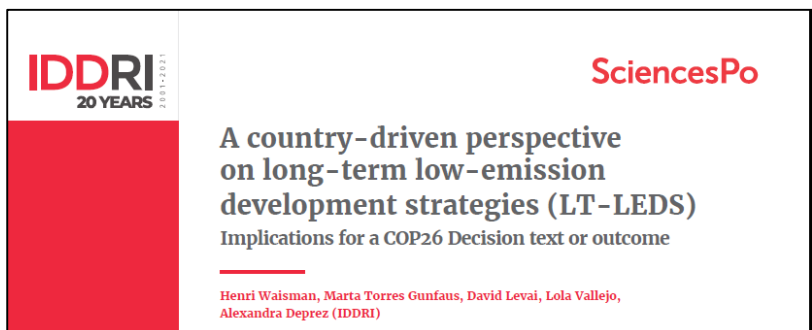


Long-term low emission development strategies: Why? How?

- ❑ Support the collective effort to achieve the Paris Climate Agreement objectives
 - Art 4.19 (need a renewed invitation at COP26)
 - link with revised NDCs and Global Stocktake
- ❑ The domestic benefits of LT-LEDS
 - Explore different options towards carbon neutrality
 - Inform short-term decisions that create opportunities and avoid costly lock-ins
 - Provide sectoral roadmaps
 - Maximizes synergies between mitigation and development
 - Guide policy packages, investments and actions by various actors
 - Identify capacity needs for effective implementation.
 - Inform requirements for international support and partnerships

Key principles for the elaboration of a useful LT-LEDS

- ❑ Should be seen as a living document (not a one shot exercise)
 - Regular revisions to capture changes of global and national situations
 - Robust (cross-ministerial) institutions and governance

- ❑ The value lies more in the process than in the document itself
 - Favors ownership by a wide range of domestic actors
 - Explores different options and confronts different views
 - Multi-stakeholder and open process

- ❑ Provide detailed narratives of transformation
 - Target setting and quantification is not the primary objective
 - Key role of technical local teams (inside and outside government) trained to conduct scenario analysis beyond modelling
