GETTING THERE

Rio de Janeiro/Galeão – Antonio Carlos Jobim International Airport (GIG), popularly known by its original name Galeão International Airport, is the main airport serving Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. It is located 20km from the city centre. A car ride to the Hilton takes around 30 minutes (allow extra time at peak hours)

- **Public transport**

BRT + Subway

BRT (Bus Rapid Transport) is a faster option for Galeao Airport as there are exclusive bus lanes in Rio de Janeiro.

There are two BRT line options to reach the airport: the TransCarioca line with stops passing through 47 stations and 5 terminals along the way, and TransCarioca Express, which departs from Terminal Alvorada, with stops on the Fundão Terminal, Vicente de Carvalho Station (integration with the subway) and Madureira.

In Galeao Airport there are two stations serving passengers:

Galeão – Tom Jobim 1: located in the Terminal 1 arrivals – H door

Galeão – Tom Jobim 2: located in the Terminal 2 arrivals – D door

The nearest metro station from Galeão Airport is the Vicente de Carvalho, on line 2. To get to the airport, it is necessary to transfer to the BRT at this station, with a direct route to the airport.

Opening Hours

Monday to Saturday: 5 a.m. to midnight

Sundays and holidays: 7 a.m. to 11 p.m.

Travel time can arrive 1h30 to the south side of Rio de Janeiro.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Participants are personally responsible for ensuring that they are in possession of the correct documentation prior to their departure. We cannot assist in procuring passports and visas except to provide an invitation letter for visa purposes, which you can request when registering. Please consult Brazilian authorities in your country to check if a visa is required.

Please ensure that your international traveller's insurance is valid and that coverage will be available in Brazil for the duration of your stay. We do not accept responsibility for any consequences from a delegate failing to ensure that he or she has complied with the necessary health, passport and visa requirements.

DRESS CODE

Dress code during the launch event will be business-casual.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Climate: Average temperatures in Rio de Janeiro in December range from 29° / 23° °C.

Currency: The monetary unit of Brazil is the Real.

Electrical supply: The power supply voltage in Rio de Janeiro is 110 V.

Water: Prefer bottled water.

Language: Portuguese is the official language of Brazil. English is little spoken outside of business centres and hotels.

Telephone services: The country code for Brazil is +55.

Time zone: Brazil is 3 hours behind of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT- 3). [\[World Clock\]](#)

Tipping: The service charge for dining at restaurants is generally not included in the price of the meal, showing as separate charge. If you feel the service was fair, you are expected to leave a tip (typically 10%) in addition to the price on the bill, although it is not mandatory. In bars and cafes, it is usual to round up or leave some small change.
