

Diana Epstein is the Evidence Team Lead at the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). The Evidence Team collaborates with other OMB offices to set evidence building priorities and select appropriate evaluation methodologies, use findings from evaluations and other studies in program design, and develop agency capacity to build and use evidence. The team helps lead Evidence Act implementation, chairs the Evaluation Officer Council, and provides expert advice and technical assistance on evidence-related activities and initiatives for a broad range of Federal agencies and functions.
