PCD in the post-2015 context – so far

- PCD was already part of the **DAC report “Shaping the 21st Century”** (1996) which made a major contribution to the genesis of the MDGs
- PCD is part of the report of the **UN System Task Team on the Post-2015 Development Agenda** (“Realizing the future we want for all”) (July 2012)
- PCD is part of the post-2015 implementation project of the **OECD Strategy for Development** (since summer 2012)
- PCD is part of the **OECD approach to post-2015** (October 2012, draft for consultation)
- PCD is part of the **DAC HLM** issue paper on Post-2015 (December 2012)
- Not yet sure whether PCD will be part of the work of the **UN High Level Panel of Eminent Persons on the Post-2015 Development Agenda** (no evidence so far)

PCD in the post-2015 context – in the near future

- **UNGA 2013:** start of the post-2015 debate in the UNGA
 - **UNGA 2015:** UN resolution on a follow-up framework
- = opportunities not to be missed

PCD in the post-2015 context – Alternative ways to conceptualize PCD

- **MDG 8** means continued work on PCD stepping up efforts to: develop further an open, rule-based, non-discriminatory trading and financial system (8A); address the special needs of the LDCs (8B); address the special needs of landlocked developing countries and small island developing states (8C); deal comprehensively with the debt problems of developing countries (8D); provide access to affordable essential drugs in developing countries (8E); and make available the benefits of new technologies, especially information and communication (8F)
- **Well-being** as an ultimate outcome (see How-is-Life-approach developed by STD and the 4th OECD World Forum, New Delhi, October 2012)
- **Global Public Goods** (to be further explored, i.a. in the context of the Development Cooperation Report 2013)
