Workshop agenda

7-9 July 2020



The Superior Audit of the Federation (ASF) and the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) signed an agreement to facilitate the implementation of the ASF's mandate, which includes the setup of a new unit focused on public infrastructure audits, the analysis of regulatory policy and institutional performance issues and the use of data analytics to strategically steer audits. The agreement includes capacity building to address these challenges through specialised workshops conducted by OECD and national superior audit officials from OECD countries. In particular, this workshop focuses on the development of technical capacities relative to regulatory quality and institutional performance.
