# Temporary regulations

- COVID-19 regulations are temporary regulations
- Sunset clauses
- Often with possibility to extend the regulation for a new period





# Fast track procedure

## No specific fast track procedure

### But some steps can be omitted or done with urgency:



- The intra/interdepartmental preparation of a draft can be done with high urgency.
- The period of internet consultation can be shortened or omitted.
- Special arrangement for implementation of EU-directives.
- Request for an urgent advice by the Council of State.
- The Cabinet can ask parliament to speed up the parliamentary process but parliament decides.



# Practice of regulatory instruments

- Use of IAK (= Dutch RIA: [www.naarhetiak.nl](http://www.naarhetiak.nl)) but mostly based on already available information.
- Sometimes public consultation ([www.internetconsultatie.nl](http://www.internetconsultatie.nl)) but foremost specific stakeholder-consultation
- Scrutiny, but in a very short time
- Not enough time for thorough evaluation now...
- What after the crisis?
