Dominique Bureau is General Delegate of the Economic Council for sustainable development at the French Ministry of Ecology and he chairs its Green Tax Commission. He is also Chairman of the French Public Statistics Authority and lecturer at the École Polytechnique.

He was formerly in charge of the Economic and International Affairs department for the French Ministry of Equipment, after creating the Economic Studies and Environmental Assessment department at the Environment Ministry and contributed to creation of the Economic Analysis Council. He started his career with the Finance Ministry in the Treasury and Budget departments. He participated in many administrative reports like those of Marcel Boiteux on transport investment choices or those of Paul Champsaur on the opening to competition of telecoms and electricity and those with François Bourguignon on fiscal reform. He has been member of the Boards of Aéroports de Paris and of the Railways regulator.

Author of scientific articles in applied public economics, as « Public transport infrastructure, urban sprawl, and post-carbon cities (2011) », he is member of the scientific committees of La Fabrique de la Cité and of Grand Paris Express.
