Virginie Marchal is a policy advisor at the Environment directorate of the OECD since 2010. Her research areas include green finance and investment for low-carbon infrastructure (renewable energy, sustainable mobility, climate-smart agriculture and green cities). She co-authored the report *Aligning Policies for a Low-carbon Economy*, a joint report with the International Energy Agency the International Transport Forum and the Nuclear Energy Agency commissioned for the 2015 OECD Ministerial Council Meeting. She is currently researching decarbonisation pathways in G20 countries.

Prior to joining the OECD, Virginie hold several positions in the oil and gas industry for BP Biofuels in London, Total Gas Argentina and Total France. She also collaborated with IDDRI and the European Climate Foundation during her studies. Virginie holds a management degree from Ecole des Hautes Etudes Commerciales (HEC, Paris) and a Master of Public Affairs from Sciences-Po Paris (Sustainable Development).
