Dyala Jiménez Figueres was sworn in as Minister of Foreign Trade of Costa Rica on 2 July 2018. She is responsible for Costa Rican foreign trade policies and attraction of foreign investment, as well as the representation before several multilateral organizations, such as SIECA, WTO and OECD.

Ms. Jimenez has over 20 years of professional experience as a lawyer. She is internationally recognized as expert in international arbitration, area in which she was a university professor and international speaker. Prior to her designation as Minister, she worked in several law firms in Costa Rica, Chile, and France, as well as in the International Chamber of Commerce. She has also held several public service positions, such as Executive Director and Advisor to the First Vice-presidency of Costa Rica, Advisor to the Minister of Treasury, and Parliamentary Advisor.

She is an Attorney at Law graduated from the University of Costa Rica, with a Masters degree of Georgetown University in the United States of America.
