OECD ONLINE PLATFORM FOR SCHOOLS OF GOVERNMENT

We have launched an **electronic interactive platform for the OECD Network of Schools of Government**. This platform is a dedicated space for all Network participants, which has been created to enable you to:

- **Interact and share** experiences and information on topics pertaining to governance, public administration and public policy;
- **Access materials** developed by the OECD and other members of the Network, categorised by topic;
- **Learn about forthcoming events** at the OECD and participating schools;
- **Participate** in discussions and consultation on governance and policy topics;
- **Identify partners** for joint research or other projects.

2014 OECD SURVEY ON SCHOOLS OF GOVERNMENT

2. **In-depth questions:** A set of 57 questions that aim to provide a more in-depth perspective on the topics touched upon by the core questions, which can be completed by **20 December 2014**.
