<b>REGISTRATION</b>	<p>All registered participants will have received an e-mail message with a bar code that they need to show to gain access to the OECD. [If you have not received this, please try checking your “spam” messages]. If you have been invited as a speaker, please also bring your invitation letter.</p> <p>On arrival at the OECD, you must register at the Reception desk to obtain a badge. Please bring photo identification with you on both days. Badges must be worn at all times.</p> <p>For security reasons, all visitors to the OECD are required to pass through a metal detector and all visitors’ bags are X-rayed. We encourage you to register at least 30 minutes in advance of the official start of the meeting to allow time for all formalities. Multiple events take place at the OECD conference centre and there can be long lines.</p>
