Recommandation Data Actions (3)

International coordination for Data Governance

Transparency and Traceability of Data Collection and Sharing

- Heterogenous clinical data sources
- Data transformation and usage

Data qualification: inclusion and exclusion criteria

- Due to diverse clinical pathways of patients,

Otherwise “Garbage In – Garbage Out”

Recommendation Algorithms Actions (3)

Technological Mastering of **AI algorithms** and **making sense** in each step of **AI system lifecycle**

- Reproducibility
- Repeatability
- **Controlling the side effects of algorithms** in the same way as controlling the side effects of new drugs when they come to market
