Previously he worked in the Translation Department of the European Parliament (Luxembourg) and of the European Economic and Social Committee (Brussels) translating from English, French, Danish and Italian into Greek. Since the 1980's he has published numerous articles on European Union Affairs, international relations, rural policy, etc. in the Greek, Cypriot and Belgian Press, while he had as well a weekly cooperation with "New TV of Crete" regarding the regional and the rur
