#### **MASSIMO D'AZEGLIO HOTEL ROME \*\*\*\***

After hiring a manager and staff, he bought the rest of the building and transformed it into Hotel Massimo D'Azeglio.

Since then, the hotel has welcomed guests of all nationalities into a building that - in spite of its many renovations - has been able to hold onto its late nineteenth century atmosphere and style.

Its proximity to the subway station enables you to move around the city easily, and the direct airport train, taking you to and from the Leonardo da Vinci Fiumicino airport, is available only a short walk away at the Termini Railway Station.

Its proximity to the Termini Railway Station and the subway station enables you to move around the city easily, and the direct airport train, taking you to and from the Leonardo da Vinci Fiumicino airport, is available only a short walk away at the Termini Railway Station.

After 8 stops get out of the bus at TOR VERGATA/SCHIAVONETTI  
Walk for 980 metres until Via Baragiola.
