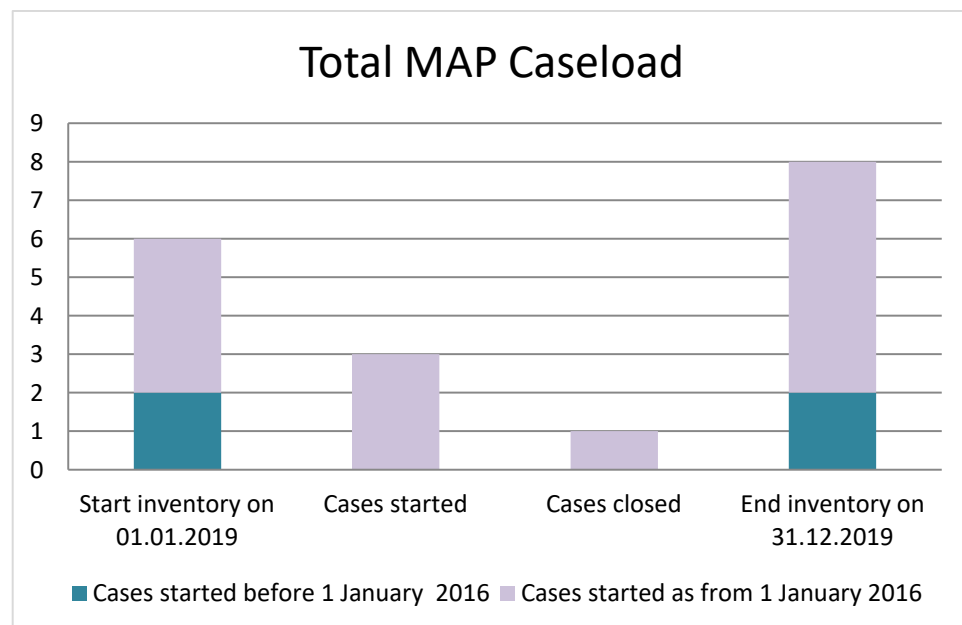

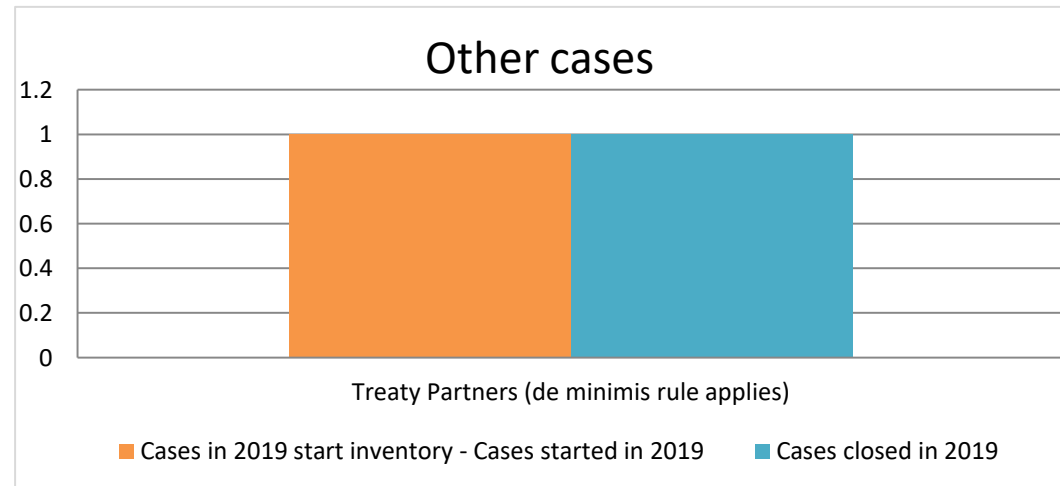
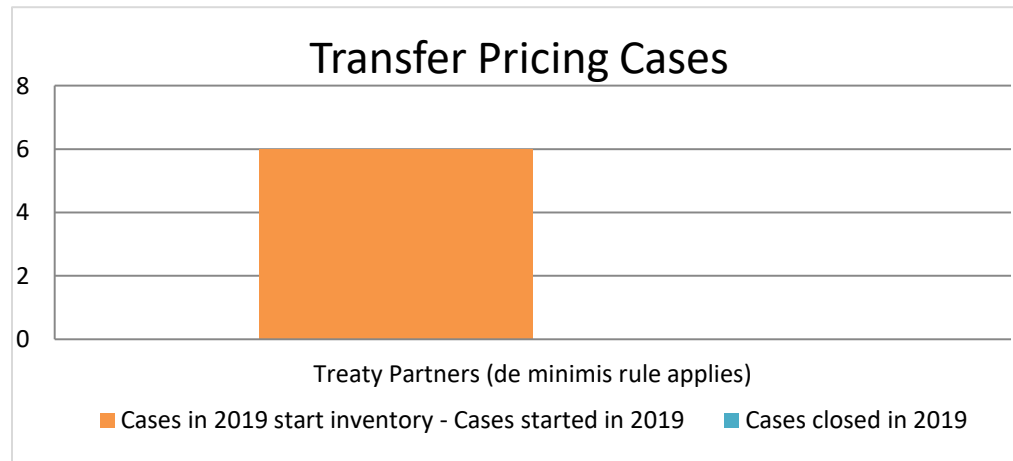

Note: the MAP cases started before 1 January 2016 and closed in 2019 are not shown in these graphs



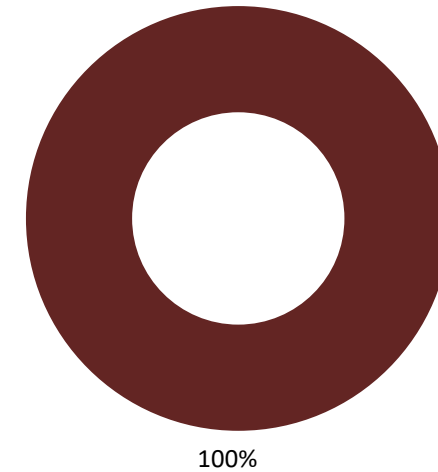
