

Creation of a Tax Regulations Implementation Team



- 1 When a bill is introduced in Congress, it may have implications for the work of Servicio de Impuestos Internos (SII, Internal Revenue Service).
- 2 RIT members identify and analyze the bill, as well as laws already published, to find their potential impact on the SII functions.
- 3 The implications, identified by the RIT, are validated in meetings with the work teams responsible for the issues addressed in the bill or published law and are recorded in an institutional instrument called "Map of Implications" in which products, responsible parties, and deadlines are identified.
- 4 The work teams collaborate, in coordination with the RIT, including the opinion of taxpayers and intermediaries, to develop the different products and services within the defined deadlines.
- 5 Finally, both officials and taxpayers are provided with the tools and instructions to facilitate compliance with the latest reforms on tax legislation.
